
Election 2022

The new constitution introduces four newly created Board Director roles and we now begin the process of finding the right candidates. Delegate Verification Form

The Election process

- Nominations (1 July 25 August)
- Review of Candidates (26 August 15 September)
- Electronic voting (16 September 27 October)
- Appointment of elected Directors (28 October)

Delegate Appointee Process

We will use the details of the delegate who attended and voted the AGM as the delegate who will vote on behalf of your Sub Branch in the upcoming director elections, unless you notify us otherwise as set out below. You can change your delegate at any time until 5pm on Friday, 12 August 2022.

Your delegate will need to have access to a PC, laptop or mobile device and email account.

You will also need to hold a general meeting once voting has opened to instruct your delegate on which candidate to vote for.

Scenario 1 – Appoint new delegate(s)

You will need to hold a general meeting and pass a resolution if you would like to appoint a new delegate. A sample of the required motion is:

That:

- [insert name], being a Service or Life Member of the [insert Sub Branch name], is appointed as Delegate for the purposes of voting in the 2022 RSL Queensland director elections, and
- In the event that he/she cannot vote, [insert name], being a Service or Life Member of the [insert Sub Branch name], is appointed as Delegate for the purposes of voting in the 2022 RSL Queensland director elections.

Please complete a new <u>Verification Form</u> and attach an extract of the minutes from the meeting where the delegates were appointed. Email both documents to your District Secretary and <u>CompanySecretary@rslqld.org</u>.

Scenario 2 – Notify that the delegate that voted at the AGM is not the delegate who will be voting in the director elections

An email from an officeholder at the Sub Branch is sufficient, given we already have evidence on file regarding the other delegate's appointment. The email should state the following:

Please update the [insert Sub Branch name] delegate for the purposes of voting in the 2022 RSL Queensland director elections from XX to YY. XX is unable to vote in the election.

Scenario 3 – Notify of previous delegate appointment

If your Sub Branch previously appointed a delegate for the 2022 AGM but have not notified State Branch, please complete a new <u>Verification Form</u> and attach an extract of the minutes from the meeting where the delegate(s) was appointed. Email both documents to your District Secretary and <u>CompanySecretary@rslqld.org</u>

Transitional Election Process





*If no further voting is required for tied Director position/s. If any candidates for the same Director role receive an equal number of votes, additional ballots for that role will be provided to each District and Sub branch for a re-vote.
